

Susquehanna SPCA Emergency Care Program

Program summary

The COVID-19 (Coronavirus disease) crisis has spurred the creation of the Susquehanna SPCA Emergency Care Program. This program will assist people who are or who become too ill to care for their pets. Those registering for the program will be required to understand and sign an agreement which will hold the Susquehanna SPCA harmless.

Requirements to register

There are no requirements to register, we simply ask that folks have explored the option of keeping pets in their home with the help of friends or family first. The priority is always to keep pets in their home where they are most comfortable but we understand not everyone has people nearby who can provide this assistance – that is why we have developed this program.

Frequently asked questions

Is there a fee for the program?

No, unless your pet needs vaccinations, in which case you would be charged at our cost.

Does my pet need to be up-to-date on vaccinations?

No, but if it is not and it enters the program, we will vaccinate at cost.

Will my pet be spayed/neutered during its stay in the program?

No, this is just a temporary boarding program.

Do I need to provide food for my pet while it is in the program?

No, but if you can supply us with even some of the food your pet has been eating it will be easier on your pet's belly to adjust.

Will my pet be in the shelter?

Not necessarily. We have developed a list of trusted Susquehanna SPCA supporters who are willing to foster when folks are in need. The location of the pet would be determined case by case based on what will be best for the animal.

If my pet is on special medication or diet can you still help?

Yes, please just make sure you provide all the necessary information and medication/special food (if possible).

What if my pet has behavioral issues?

We can still help. However, the likelihood that the animal would remain at the shelter for their temporary stay increases.
